



HOUSE RULES FOR RIDERS, VISITORS AND OWNERS OF HORSES / PONIES

For the benefit of safety and riding pleasure for all of us, our riding school has a number of house rules. We count on your cooperation.

The following applies to everyone:

- Spectators should behave calmly and should not interfere with the course of events in a riding lesson.
- Do not run or shout in the stables; there must also be peace around the riding arena.
- Smoking is not allowed in the stables or on horseback.
- Instructions from the stable staff and instructors must be followed by everyone.
- The corridors of the stable should always be tidy; riding gear and tools must be put away immediately after use.

The following applies to every rider:

- While riding, the riding arena rules must be observed.
- Alcohol consumption before or during horse riding is not permitted.
- Customers and volunteers are only allowed to brush horses/ponies, guide them to and from the stable and (un)saddle them if this is done under the supervision of stable staff.
- Customers or volunteers are allowed to care for horses without supervision if they have followed a short theoretical and practical instruction at the riding school.
